The Gathering of Nations Pow Wow is an experience for all people to see the colorful native costumes, beautiful dancing and to hear the songs of over 3,000 indigenous, Native American Indian dancers and singers representing more than 500 tribes from Canada and the United States. We will also be able to witness the thrilling dance, singing, and drumming competitions.

The trading of intercultural traditions and crafts is an experience for all who attend. **The Indian Traders Market** offers a very special shopping experience and exhibition of Native American artifacts. Over 800 artists, crafters, and traders will place their wares on display and for sale.

We will also be sure to visit some of the other interesting sights in Albuquerque.

- **Old Town** - Old Albuquerque's well preserved Spanish plaza surrounded by restaurants and shops selling rugs, Native American jewelry and crafts.
- A trip on the **Sandia Peak Aerial Tramway** will transport us above deep canyons and breathtaking terrain. We'll see some of nature's more dramatic beauty unfold before us.
- ◆ At the **Indian Pueblo Cultural Center**, the exhibit, **Our Land, Our Culture, Our Story**, features a brief historical overview of the Pueblo world, and a contemporary exhibit featuring original artwork and craftsmanship of each of the 19 Pueblos of today. We will also eat at the Pueblo Harvest Café which features a Native Fusion cuisine inspired by the traditions and ingredients cultivated by Pueblo ancestors.
